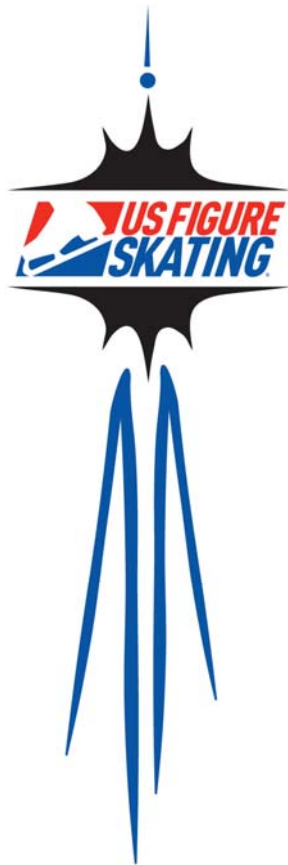

TECHNICAL ANNOUNCEMENT

1. GENERAL

The 2008 U.S. Figure Skating Qualifying Competition Season consists of a total of 14 events including, 12 qualifying events (9 Regional Championships, 3 Sectional Championships), the 2008 U.S. Junior Championships (Juvenile & Intermediate) and the 2008 State Farm U.S. Figure Skating Championships (Novice, Junior & Senior). All 14 events are sanctioned by U.S. Figure Skating and conducted according to the most current U.S. Figure Skating rulebook, 2007 edition, with changes and clarifications as posted on the USFS website and this announcement. Compliance with these rules as updated or amended is the responsibility of the participants. U.S. Figure Skating reserves the right to incorporate revisions to the International Judging System (IJS) made by the ISU for junior and senior events and by U.S. Figure Skating to novice events and below.

The Qualifying and National Championship Competitions are only open to competitors who are current members of U.S. Figure Skating and who meet the eligibility requirements according to U.S. Figure Skating Rule 3035, all age and test requirements pertaining to the event you are entering, and the citizen and residency requirements as stated in Rule 3065.

Non-U.S. Citizens who have already received a letter of permission from the Chair of the Competitions Committee and were accepted to compete in the U.S. Figure Skating qualifying system are eligible to register. All other non-US citizens seeking eligibility must meet the requirements set forth in Rule 3065.

Any coach being credentialed at a U.S. Figure Skating competition is required to be a current member in good standing of both U.S. Figure Skating and the Professional Skaters Association (PSA).

Important Notice for all Novice Pairs and Dance Teams (New for 2008)

Beginning with the 2008 competition season, all novice pairs and dance teams will begin their qualifying at their respective sectional championships. These events will no longer be offered at the regional championships.

Important Notice for all Juvenile/Intermediate Pairs and Dance Teams (New for 2008)

Beginning with the 2008 competition season, all juvenile and intermediate pairs and dance teams will advance automatically to the 2008 U.S. Junior Championships. There will be no event for these teams at the regional championships. However, these teams will have the option of competing at their respective sectional championships November 14 – 17, 2007.

The decision of whether or not to compete at the sectional championships must be made during the initial registration process (deadline Sept. 1, 2007). This decision is binding. Those teams who elect not to

competitors will automatically advance to the U.S. Junior Championships. Those teams who elect to compete at sectionals **must compete** in the event in order to advance to the Junior Championships.

2. REGISTRATION

A. METHOD

Online Electronic Registration (Required)

Online registration is the ONLY method available for entry into the 2008 U.S. Figure Skating Qualifying Competition Season.

To enter online into the 2008 Qualifying Competition Season, you must do the following:

Log on to www.usfsaonline.org. A username and password are required elements for successful online registration. Your username is your U.S. Figure Skating membership #. If you do not already have a password, go to www.usfsaonline.org first and follow the online instructions.

If you are experiencing difficulty with online registration, please call the U.S. Figure Skating main number at (719) 635-5200 or email the U.S. Figure Skating member services department at memberservices@usfigureskating.org.

B. DEADLINES

The entry deadline for the 2008 Qualifying Competition Season is **11:59 p.m., September 1, 2007**. The time zone of your principal training center/primary residence (juvenile, intermediate) or home club (novice, junior, senior) will determine the entry deadline of 11:59 p.m., Sept. 1, 2007. **NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE! NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DEADLINE!**

Age requirements must be met by **September 1, 2007**.

Test requirements must also be met by **September 1, 2007**. Provisional entries based on passing a test after the closing date of entries will not be accepted. Please refer to USFS Rules 3107, 3108 and 3109 for further testing information and guidelines.

C. BYES

No medical byes will be considered. Competitors awarded a bye to their sectional championships or the U.S. Championships will receive official notification in writing from U.S. Figure Skating. However, all competitors, including those who receive a bye, wishing to compete in the 2008 Qualifying Competition Season must enter by the stated deadline.

D. ENTRY FEES

All competitors entering the 2008 Qualifying Competition Season must submit payment of the appropriate entry fee (amounts listed below) to U.S. Figure Skating. All competitors are required to pay both the entry fee into the qualifying competition season (for each event entered) and the administrative fee. All fees are nonrefundable.

Sectional Championships Qualifying Entry Fees

Those singles skaters advancing, regardless of method, from their regional championships to the sectional championships will incur an additional \$150 entry fee plus \$10 administrative fee. This total will automatically be charged to the credit card that paid the initial entry fee.

Your registration is not considered valid until all appropriate entry and administrative fees have been paid and all required forms have been completed online to U.S. Figure Skating.

E. PAYMENT

Online payment via credit card is the ONLY accepted form of payment. For those competitors advancing to sectionals from their regional championships, the credit card used for the initial entry process will be automatically charged the additional sectional entry fee.

Once entered, all withdrawals are considered final. A skater may not reenter even if the withdrawal occurs prior to the entry deadline on September 1, 2007.

3. TECHNICAL DETAILS

A. CONDUCT OF EVENTS

For the 2008 season, all events and levels at all championship competitions (regionals, sectionals, U.S. Junior Championships, U.S. Championships) will be conducted in accordance with the International System of Judging (IJS).

B. AGE and TEST QUALIFICATIONS

All age and test requirements can be found in the U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook starting with USFS Rule 3640 (senior singles) and on the U.S. Figure Skating website at www.usfigureskating.org/New_Judging.asp?id=311.

C. TECHNICAL ELEMENTS

The well-balanced program charts for all levels and disciplines are posted on the U.S. Figure Skating website at www.usfigureskating.org/New_Judging.asp?id=311. As referenced earlier in this announcement, U.S. Figure Skating will incorporate all changes made by the ISU in regards to well-balanced programs. Please refer to this website often for continuous updates.

All competitors entering into the 2008 Qualifying Competition Season are required as part of their online registration to submit a planned program content sheet (PPCS) detailing the elements in their program(s). You may update your PPCS at www.usfsaonline.org up to one week prior to the start of your competition.

D. MUSIC

COMPETITION MUSIC INFORMATION (NEW FOR 2008)

Beginning with the 2008 competition season, U.S. Figure Skating will require all competitors to fully complete a competition music information form as part of the online registration process.

The following information is required for each piece of music used for the short program/original dance and free skate/free dance: Composer, Orchestra, Duration of Music, Record Label/Number (Optional but highly recommended if obtainable).

For all qualifying events during the 2008 season, CDs are the only acceptable forms of media. **Cassettes will NOT be accepted.** CDs must be clearly marked with name, event entered and the music length. **Each CD must have only ONE (1) track on it. In the case of short and long programs, two (2) separate disks must be used.** Any disc with more than one (1) track will NOT be accepted! Lead in time (time before the music begins) on CDs may not exceed two (2) seconds. Each CD must be in a standard hard sided "jewel case" or CD sleeve, also labeled with the skater's name and event. Jewel cases and CDs that are not properly identified will NOT be accepted. **Due to compatibility and reliability reasons music may NOT be submitted on re-recordable "CD-RW" discs.**

Competition music must be turned in at the registration desk at the time of registration and will be available for pick up at the registration desk at the conclusion of the event. At the regional championships, competitors will not receive their credentials at registration until they turn in their music. The originals used at regionals will be forwarded to sectionals and the U.S. Junior Championships for those advancing. The originals used at sectionals will be forwarded on to the U.S.

Championships for those advancing. Skaters advancing to the U.S. Championships will need to provide the name and composer of each piece of music. CDs will not be mailed back to competitors.

All competitors must have at least one (1) additional copy (CD) rinkside at practice sessions and during the actual competition event. The local organizing committee will accept no responsibility for damage or loss of CDs.

U.S. Figure Skating will supply current dance music for compulsory dances.

E. OFFICIAL BULLETIN BOARD

The official bulletin board will contain any announcements or changes and it is the responsibility of the competitors to check it often for official notices. Please refer to the local portion of the announcement for further information regarding the bulletin board.

4. ADVANCEMENT TO SECTIONALS/U.S. JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

A. QUALIFIERS

All singles competitors advancing to the sectional championships or the U.S. Junior Championships will receive either the announcement or instructions for retrieving the announcement for their next competition at their regional championships awards ceremony.

For every competitor, all information required to be sent to the sectional or Junior Championship local organizing committee (photos, practice ice requests, etc.) must be postmarked no later than the TUESDAY FOLLOWING YOUR REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP. Any information postmarked after the Tuesday following your regional championship will be accepted ONLY at the discretion of the local organizing committee.

For those competitors receiving a bye to either the sectional championships or the U.S. Junior Championships, you will receive your announcement either via email or regular mail and must follow the deadline set forth by the Local Organizing Committee.

B. ALTERNATES

Skaters placing in fifth and sixth place (unless there are fill-ins) at the regional championships in the novice, junior and senior singles events will be designated as first and second alternates. These competitors will be provided an event announcement as they may be selected to compete up to 48 hours before their competition event.

The succeeding two (2) placing skaters not advanced by the percentage system to the U.S. Junior Championships in juvenile and intermediate singles will become the first and second alternates respectively. All alternates will be provided an announcement for the U.S. Junior Championships.

Alternates do not need to mail in any paperwork or required forms unless contacted by U.S. Figure Skating.

6. ANTI-DOPING

Anti-Doping tests will be conducted at the State Farm U.S. Figure Skating Championships, held in St. Paul, Minn., January 20-27, 2008. Senior level competitors only are eligible to be tested. If selected, testing is mandatory.

REGISTRATION

The registration desk at the Olympicview Training Center shall be open throughout the week. CREDENTIALS

Security will be in place and entry will be limited to credentialed and ticketed individuals only.

Chaperone Credentials: Each skater may **name one chaperone to receive credentials free of charge**. One additional chaperone credential may be purchased for \$25.00. Chaperones will not have access to skater locker rooms or staging areas.

Coaches Credentials: Each entry may designate a maximum of two coaches for credentials. **One coach credential per competitor will be provided free of charge, all others are \$25.00**. All coaches must be current U.S. Figure Skating and PSA members to be credentialed. Coaching credentials will allow access to all venue areas, including coaches' hospitality.

Changes: Changes to chaperone and/or coach designations may be made **at the registration desk**. Competitors will be limited to one chaperone and one coach designation change. Only a skater who is not a minor, or a parent or a legal guardian of a minor skater may designate or change an official chaperone or coach. Replacement cost for any lost credential is \$25.00.

TICKETS

An all-event ticket includes admission to all events held during this competition. **All-event tickets will be sold at the door for a cost of \$25.00 each**. Individual daily tickets will be available for purchase at the door at a cost of \$10.00.

OFFICIAL NOTICES

Official bulletin boards will be maintained by the Seattle Skating Club at both the Olympicview Training Center and the Embassy Suites. Postings on the official bulletin boards will constitute official notice to all competitors and coaches of schedule changes or rule clarifications and other competition information. It is the skater's responsibility to check the bulletin board for event or schedule changes. No event will begin prior to the posted start time; however, **skaters should be at the arena and checked in 45 minutes prior to their event.**

TRANSPORTATION

Competitors need to arrange for their own transportation.

The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security has very strict guidelines for transporting sports equipment, including prohibiting ice skates from your carry-on baggage. SKATER SERVICES AND SKATER LOCKER ROOMS

Minor repairs and skate sharpening will be available at the rink by the Olympicview Training Center Pro-Shop.

Dress repair, hair and makeup will also be available for last minute needs.

MEDICAL SERVICES

First Aid will be on site during the competition and will assist with immediate medical attention. If necessary, 911 will be called. The local hospital is five minutes by car from the arena. A local dentist will be on call for competitors.

QUALIFYING COMPETITORS PRACTICE ICE

Official practice ice sessions will begin on Tuesday, Oct. 16, 2007 and may be held at either the Olympicview Training Center or the Lynnwood Ice Center. Qualifying practice ice will be sold as a package. **For juvenile competitors, this package includes ONE freeskate session and ONE final round warm-up. For all other qualifying level competitors (intermediate through senior), this package includes ONE short program session, ONE short program final round warm up, ONE freeskate session and ONE final round freeskate warm-up. All official practice ice sessions will be 30 minutes. Music will be played at all official practice ice sessions. All warm ups will be 20 minutes in duration and no music will be played. The cost of this package is \$20 per juvenile competitor and \$40 for all intermediate thru senior competitors.**

Unofficial practice ice sessions may be held at either Olympicview Training Center or Lynnwood Ice Center. Sessions will be **30 minutes in length** and sold on an individual session basis. **The cost of each session is \$12.00. A competitor may request ONE unofficial practice ice session for each short program and/or freeskate. No music will be played on unofficial practice ice.** Further practice ice sessions MAY be available for purchase on a first come first serve basis at the Registration Desk in the Olympicview Training Center, beginning Monday Oct. 15 at 4 p.m. This additional practice ice must be purchased by the coach, skater or legal guardian of the skater.

The enclosed practice ice form must be completed and submitted with a check payable to the Seattle Skating Club. A schedule will be posted online as soon as it is available – please check our website often for the most up-to-date information: www.seattleskatingclub.com.
