COMPETITION

Ice Fest is hosted by the Seattle Skating Club and will be held at the Olympic view Training Center, 22202 70th Ave. West, Mountlake Terrace, WA. This venue will be the competition rink for the 2008 NWP Regional Competition, October 16th to October 20th, 2007. Ice Fest is a non-qualifying competition and is sanctioned by US Figure Skating and the Canadian Figure Skating Association. This competition will be governed by the current U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook except as modified by this announcement. Rules passed at the 2007 Governing Council meeting CAN be incorporated into events, but no penalties will be assessed for not including these changes.

FUTURE CHAMPIONS SERIES

Now in its fourth year, the Future Champions Series is an exciting opportunity to reward skaters in the juvenile, intermediate and novice levels and encourage them to stay in the sport. It is believed that many skaters who do not achieve success in the qualifying competitions are at risk for leaving the sport during the off-season. FCS is meant to provide a venue for such skaters to compete, work toward a goal and achieve recognition.

The program works in tandem with the U.S. Figure Skating non-qualifying structure. Skaters in the juvenile, intermediate and novice levels (singles, dance and pairs) who are not otherwise ineligible accrue points based on their placements at non-qualifying competitions that are part of the series. Each section has its own series. At the end of the FCS season, each skater who has competed in at least three FCS competitions in the same discipline and level, two for pairs and dance, will be eligible for tallying of their points. The skater's best three placements will be used to calculate their point total.

The top point receivers in each section in each discipline and level will be awarded FCS medals. A gold, silver and bronze FCS medal will be awarded for each discipline/level in each section. This program is governed through US Figure Skating. Please see www.usfsa.org for more information.

ENTRIES

Entry forms and entry fees must be mailed to **Ice Fest, Registrar, 22202 70th Ave. West, Mountlake Terrace, Washington 98043**. Enclose a self-addressed, stamped legal-sized envelope to receive a copy of the competition schedule. Practice and Competition schedules will not be given over the phone. In addition, schedules will be posted on our club website at www.seattleskatingclub.org. **Entries must be POSTMARKED by MAY 1st, 2007.** Couples entering Dance & Pairs Events must send their entry forms and fees in together. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the referee and the local organizing committee and will be subject to a \$20 late entry fee. No entries will be accepted after the draw has been completed.

ELIGIBILITY

This competition is open to qualified skaters who are registered members of U.S. Figure Skating or the Canadian Figure Skating Association. Eligibility for entries is governed by tests passed and age as of deadline for entry, May 1st, 2007. All skaters should be prepared to show proof of age. Skaters may enter any combination of technical or artistic events. **Any skater may enter one event higher than the event for which he/she qualifies by test**, but may not enter more than one level in any one event except for open adult couples dance or solo dance.

EVENT JUDGING

The ISU Judging System (IJS) will be used for Juvenile – Senior levels for short program, free skate, compulsory, original and free dance events. Skaters entering these events are required to submit a planned program content sheet for **each** event entered. The planned program sheet is attached to this announcement. All other events will be judged using the 6.0 system.

REFUNDS

Refunds will be issued in accordance with the 2007 Official U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook and are available only if one of the following applies:

1. Injury with Physician's written recommendation that the entrant not skate must be mailed to the registrar and postmarked no later than June 4th, 2007.
2. There is a death in the competitor's immediate family.
3. The event is not held.

To withdraw, notify THE REGISTRAR immediately. All refunds will be mailed within 30 days after the completion of the competition.

FACILITIES

The ice surface is indoors, 100' X 200', with slightly rounded corners. It is located at Olympicview Training Center, 22202 -70th

Avenue West, Mountlake Terrace, WA 98043.

REGISTRATION

The official registration desk will be located at Olympicview Training Center lobby, beginning one hour before the competition. All Competitors are required to register as soon as possible after arrival at the rink. Competition CDs should be turned in at this time.

FEES

Fees must accompany entry forms and be **POSTMARKED by May 1st, 2007**. For IJS events (Juvenile through Senior – free style, pairs and dance) the entry fee is \$100 for the first event, \$140 for 2 events and \$30 for each additional event entered beyond 2. These increased fees are to help cover the additional expense of using the mini-system – computer & video equipment and officials. For Non-IJS events (Non-test through Open Juvenile) the entry fee is \$75 for the first event, \$110 for 2 events, and \$30 for each additional event entered beyond 2. The entry fee for Pairs and Couples Dance is \$120 per team for the 1st Event, \$40 per team for each additional event. (i.e. compulsory dance and free dance are two events). The exceptions are Solo and Adult Dance events, the cost is \$30 per dance. Checks should be made payable to Seattle Skating Club. If Canadian currency, please add \$5 per event. A fee of \$30 will be charged for checks returned for non-sufficient funds (NSF) and must be paid prior to the start of competition to compete.

AWARDS

Awards will be presented at the photographer's table immediately after the official posting of each event. Awards will be given for first through sixth place for Non-Test through Pre-Juvenile in the US Figure Skating Events. First through fourth place will be awarded for Juvenile through Adult events. Award Photographs will be taken and we ask that all award winners pose for the group picture even if you do not plan on purchasing a picture. Awards placement for the "**Special Awards**" shall be determined by the event judges.

Rosalynn Sumners - Seattle Skating Club "Artistic Award"

Awarded to an Intermediate and above skater for exceptional Artistic Performance as determined by the event judges.

The Shirle Irene Lander Trophy

Awarded to a Juvenile and below skater for exceptional Artistic Performance as determined by the event judges.

"The Hadley Award"

This shall be awarded to a skater of any level who demonstrates excellence in both artistic and free skating and also represents the spirit of figure skating at the Ice Fest Event as determined by the event judges. Seattle Skating Club members, Ila Rae & Ray Hadley, were the 1960 US Silver Pairs Champions & 1957 Junior Pairs National Champions. They, along with their coach and mother Linda Hadley, perished with the other members of the 1961 U.S. World Team when their plane crashed en route to the World Championships. This special award is made in their name.

Special Awards to be presented at the completion of the appropriate events. The perpetual trophies will remain in the SSC showcase, engraved with the skater's name. The winning skater shall also receive a personal award from the Seattle Skating Club.

MUSIC

Music must be reproduced on CD (no CDRWs). Cassette tapes will not be accepted. CD's must contain music for only one program. Clearly label music with the skater's name, his/her professional's name, the event, and the time the music plays. PLEASE DO NOT USE STICKY LABELS. Instead, write the information on the CD with a sharpie. Labels tend to stick in the music player. Music must be turned in at the time of official registration. All competitors must have an extra copy of their music available. Once the music is turned in, it will not be returned until the event is completed. Seattle Skating Club will not accept responsibility for breakage, damage, or loss, but will take every precaution to safeguard music media. One week following the competition any CD's not collected will be disposed of. CD's can not be returned by mail.

ADMISSION

No admission will be charged. All events are open to spectators.

OFFICIAL NOTICES

An official bulletin board will be maintained at the competition site. The official schedule showing starting times for each event and the draw will be posted on the bulletin board. The official schedule supersedes all other schedules. Notices posted on this bulletin board are considered as sufficient notice to all competitors. Skaters are to be in the rink and ready to skate 60 minutes before their event is scheduled to begin. Events will not be delayed for skaters who arrive late.

REFEREE

The decision of the referee on all matters will be final. The Referee, along with the Competition co-chair persons, shall have the right to exclude any person whose behavior is unruly or unsportsmanlike.

PRACTICE ICE - COACHES, PARENTS AND SKATERS - PLEASE READ!!!

Practice Ice shall be scheduled for all events. **Each competitor may request one \$12.00/ 30min, practice session per event entered.** After the schedule is determined, extra practice ice will be sold on a first come-first serve basis, but we can not guarantee additional practice sessions. Please see the Practice Ice Monitor at the competition.

Every effort will be made to schedule Practice ice sessions as close to the competition as possible, however this is not guaranteed.

No Changes - No Refunds. Practice ice money is non-refundable, and you may not assign your practice ice to another skater.

Music: Depending on the number of skaters on each practice ice session, there is no guarantee each skater's music will be played. If it is not possible to play all skaters music during an assigned practice ice session, then no music will be played.

Practice Ice Schedules: will not be available by phone or email. If you wish to receive a practice ice schedule you must enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope, and send it along with the official entry forms and payment.

VIDEOTAPING & PHOTOGRAPHY

Videotaping is permissible only in the upper viewing area and is not permitted at rink side. Please be courteous to those viewing the event. No flash photography is permitted. Videotapes and professional photographs, both podium and action photos, will be available to purchase.

GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS

- Events with large numbers of entries may be split into multiple groups. Large events will be split by age for Non-test through Pre-Juvenile and Adult, and by draw for Juvenile through Senior. .
- Events may be skated with more than 6 skaters per warm up group.
- Two entries in a group will constitute an event. If only entry is received in an event, the skater will have the option to withdraw for a refund, skate an exhibition, or receive a judge's critique.
- No final rounds will be skated. In singles and pairs, the long and short programs will be scored and awards given as separate events. In Couples dance, the compulsory, original and free dance will be scored and awards given as separate events.
- Skaters must skate US Figure Skating elements for the Short Program as written for the 2007-2008 season in the current rulebook. Any changes made at Governing Council CAN be incorporated into events, but no penalties will be assessed for not including these changes.
- This competition is governed by the current USFSA Rulebook except as modified by this announcement.

THE FOLLOWING EVENTS WILL BE OFFERED:

Free Skate: Non-Test through Senior, Intermediate thru Senior Short & Long Programs

Adult Singles: Pre-Bronze through Masters, age 21 years and over

Show case: Non-Test through Senior, Adult Pre-Bronze through Masters

Improvisation: Non-Test through Senior

Pairs: Preliminary through Senior

Adult Pairs: Adult Bronze through Masters

Compulsory Dance: Pre-Juvenile through Senior

Free Dance: Juvenile through Senior

Open Adult Couples Dance: All levels; no test restrictions, age 21 years and over

Solo Dance: All ages, no test restrictions

Surprise Dance: All ages all levels.

Showcase events are intended to develop and enhance the qualities of original choreography, showmanship, entertainment and interpretation of music and theme. As such, the technical content of these programs is not judged. Pre-Preliminary level may include single jumps, but no axels. Preliminary through Juvenile may include single jumps only – including axels. Intermediate through Senior may include double jumps only. Judges will take a .2 deduction for any non-allowed elements. Music may be instrumental or vocal. Props must be hand-held or those that can be easily placed and removed by the skater without assistance. Light Entertainment and Dramatic categories will be judged separately. Each judge will award one mark for Program Components.

Improvisational events provide an opportunity for skaters to demonstrate their choreographic skills. Skaters will improvise a program to music they will hear for the first time once before and again during their warm-up. No communication with coaches or audience will be allowed once the warm-up has begun. Skaters will be judged on their choreography and presentation, not technical difficulty. Each judge will award one mark for each skater for Program Components.

Surprise Dance:

Competitor's names will be drawn into couples by the referee, along with the skating order, 15 minutes before the start of the event. A couple will consist of a male and a female. Males may be expected to skate more than once if necessary. The dance for this event will be a low level dance and will be announced on the day. The purpose of this event is to enjoy the dance and have fun!
